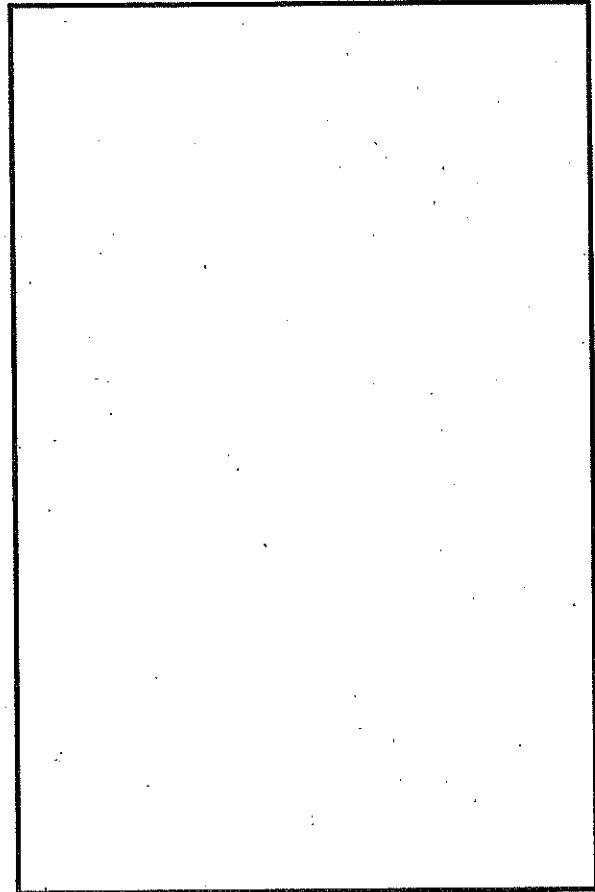

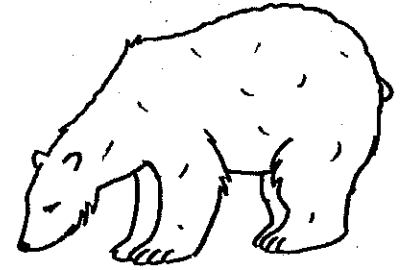

When you came home, you had a lot of photographs.

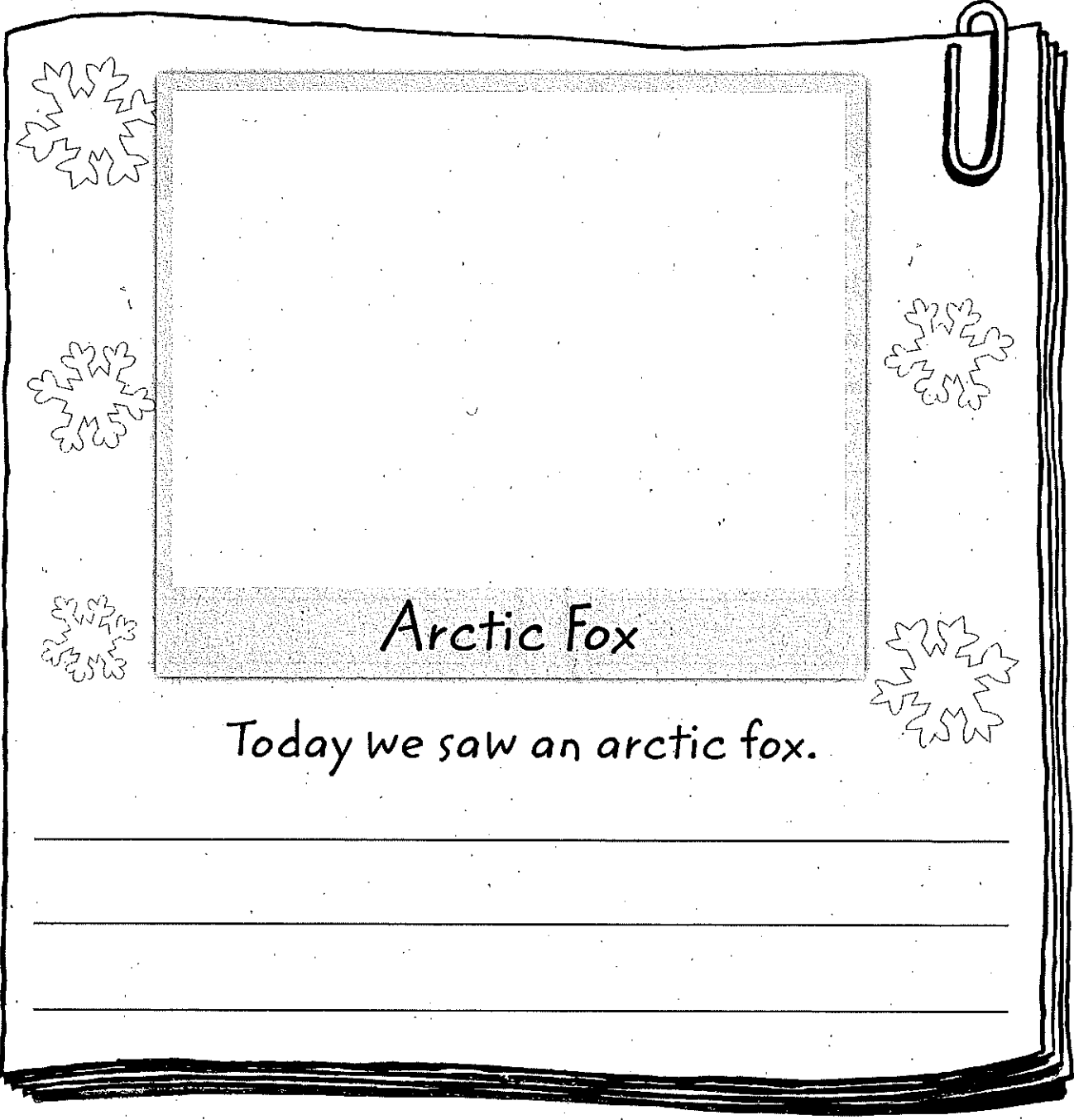
Now you are going to make a scrapbook with a page for each arctic animal. Draw a picture of each animal.

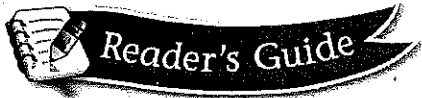

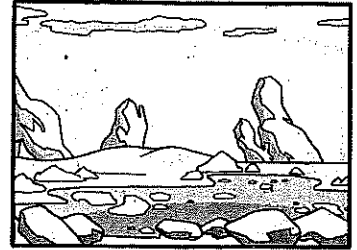

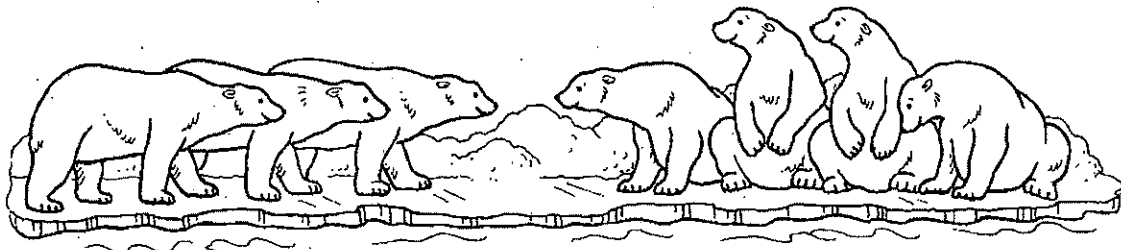
